

## Should you call 999?

Read the scenarios below and decide if they are an emergency and if you should call 999.



Olivia has fallen out of a tree and says that she can't move.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: call 999

Sam fell over in the playground and grazed his knee.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: don't call 999

Jack's Granny looks unwell. She's holding her chest in pain. She's having trouble breathing and can't speak.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: call 999

Georgia's mum was making a cup of tea when some of the hot water splashed on her arm.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: don't call 999

Katie has been stung by a bee. Her face and body have swollen and she is finding it difficult to breathe.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: call 999

Jake cut his finger on a pair of scissors and it started bleeding a little bit.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

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Harry has a tummy ache and has been sick.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: don t call 999

Charlie was playing on his scooter without wearing a helmet. He's fallen off and will not wake up.

**SHOULD YOU CALL 999?** 

Answer: call 999
