



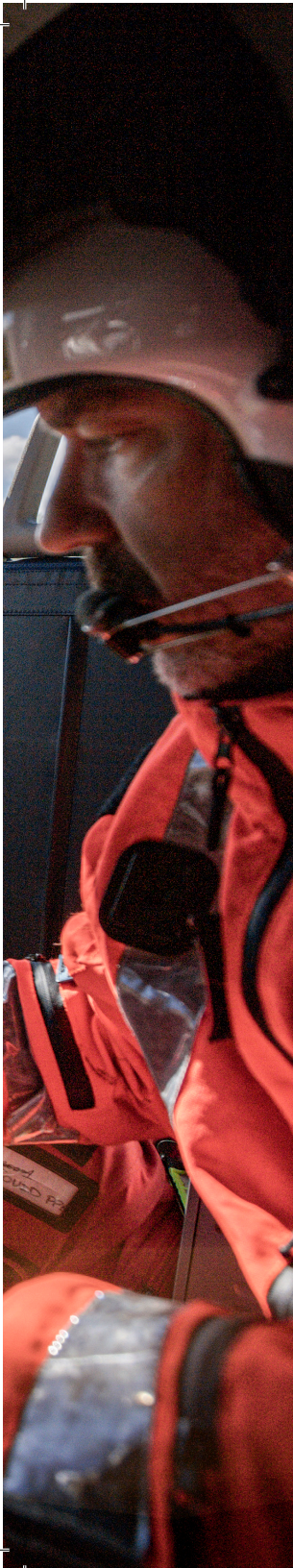

Since 2007, people like you have allowed us to be there for the most critically ill and severely injured people in our region.

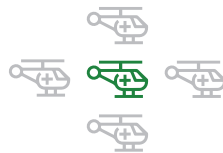

THE DIFFERENCE YOU MAKE

“Mike walked into the lounge and suddenly collapsed. There was no warning, he just fell. I dialled 999 and started CPR.”

Mike had suffered a devastating heart attack at his home in Hampshire. After an hour of CPR from paramedics and our Critical Care Team, the situation was looking very bleak for Mike and his wife Dolores.

“Almost an hour had gone by since he had collapsed, and there seemed little hope. The doctor asked me to come and sit with Mike and to prepare myself for the worst. As I sat on the floor holding Mike’s hand, they administered further medication and his pulse restarted. I was in shock. In my mind, he had gone.”

Mike spent the next five days in hospital on life support, with Dolores unsure

whether he would regain any brain function or even wake at all. Remarkably, when he eventually woke up, Mike responded to the clinical staff with Dolores sitting by his bedside.

Thanks to your support, Mike and Dolores have gone on to live a healthy and normal life.

“They never gave up on Mike even though he was unresponsive for so long. He owes Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance and the people who support them his life.”

HOW TO INCLUDE HAMPSHIRE AND ISLE OF WIGHT AIR AMBULANCE IN YOUR WILL

We always recommend using a professional Will-writing service to create or amend your Will.

If you already have a preferred Solicitor or Will-writer you will need to provide them with these three pieces of information:
